Funding requests from Teachers

- Mark Wright, Head of Year 11, has requested funding for the Year 11 prom. He has requested 5x £45 (£225) to cover refugee students and 50 x £20 (£1000) to help the FSM Students. Previously we have donated £400 towards the year 11 prom. Agreed to fund the £225 for refugee children and £500 for the prom.
- Nicole Nayar, Head of Year 10, has requested funding for the Year 10 trip to Thorpe Park. She has requested 30 x £50(£1500) for FSM to cover the total cost of their tickets or half of the tickets @£750. £500 agreed to be awarded for the trip.
- We no longer have the Merchants funding for the hardship trust. School may be able to make a bid to them for other funding in future.
