Name of Enrichment Club	Description	Year Group
Art Lab!	Students will engage with a weekly creative experiment relating to a theme - the themes will range from the surreal and bizarre, to the political and powerful! Through these experiments students will explore the power of art as a communication device, and reflect on how it can help build human connection and meaning in a digital age.	8,9,10
Basketball & Netball	Students will develop skills, tactics and knowledge of the rules of Netball and Basketball through game play. Students will participate in an end of term tournament.	8,9
Board Games (and card games)	Playing games offers more than just entertainment. It can boost your mental health and improve your social skills. Using strategy and problem solving skills will improve mental agility and keep your brain healthy. Most importantly it will be fun! Drama Club	Students will learn new theatre and performance skills through various games and activities and will get lots of practice in performing to one another.	8,9
Eco Club	We are working towards achieving the green award in school. Planning clothes swapping events, working on projects such as bird boxes, bird feeders, insect hotels and participating in the RSPB Wild award.
